and actions



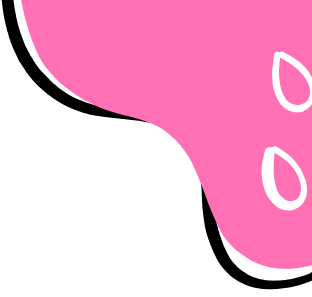


